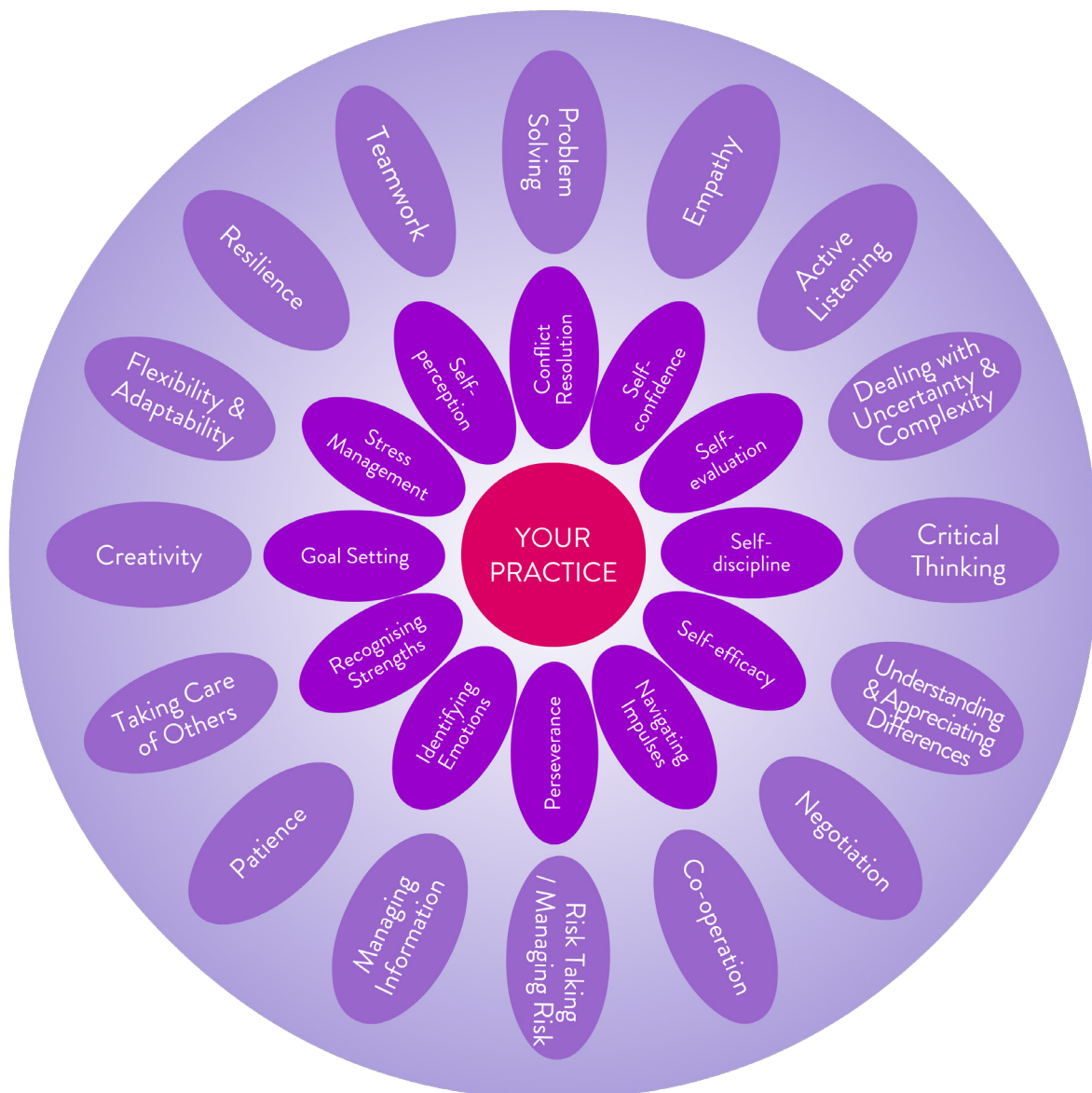


# MAP OF SOFT SKILLS
